Re: Commercial Eligibility

Dear *Jeremy*:

Thank you for your interest in Creative Saskatchewan's Feature Film and Television Production Grant Program. The program provides financial support for eligible feature film, television, and advertising projects through a grant, of which there are two streams. The Saskatchewan Stream, which includes co-productions, provides a base grant equal to the amount of 30% of the Saskatchewan spend. The Service Production Stream provides a base grant equal to 25% of the Saskatchewan spend.

Eligible productions where the majority of post-production is taking place in Saskatchewan receive a 5% post-production bonus. Productions filming in rural Saskatchewan locations receive an additional 5% bonus. Applicants eligible for our frequent filming bonus may receive a 10% bonus as well. The grant amount plus eligible bonuses may not exceed 40% of the Saskatchewan spend for applications within the Saskatchewan Stream, or 35% in the Service Production Stream.

Effective April 1, 2026 advertising commercials are considered an eligible genre to the program if they meet all of the requirements under the official program guidelines. A commitment is contingent on the availability of funds and a thorough evaluation of the project's eligibility to the program performed by Creative Saskatchewan. This letter does not constitute a letter of commitment.
